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Mars in Aries (6 Ari 19) Mars in the Third House

Mars in the Third House (or sign) gives an alert, witty and energetic nature, possibly inclined toward sarcasm. You are adventurous and physically active. You are glib and communicate very well with others, although you may be a better talker than listener. If you have any weaknesses in this area, it is in being somewhat sharp with friends and relatives, or possibly indulging in gossip.
